## Our Myths and Legends

- The British Isles is rich in myths, legends and folktales, with almost every area having its own special story.
- Use the site to explore some of these tales of the past. Each story is told using text, pictures and audio.
- There are 31 stories with over 150 mythical, legendary and historic figures from nearly 2000 years of storytelling.

## Add Your Own Work

- Pupils can add a real myth or legend, work related to an existing story, or even make up their own myth or legend.

- The uploaded work will be shared with others around the world.

## Creative Tools

- There are tools to help pupils to create their own stories and to learn more about the existing stories and their origins.
- The **story creator** allows pupils to write and view their own myths and legends.
- The **sound** and **picture galleries** contain resources for use in your own work.
- The **timeline** places the stories into a historical context.
- The **glossary** lets pupils look up any word they are not sure about.
